

# April 2024 Water Report

Water was turned on and meter reinstalled at one residence, water was turned off and meter removed at one residence, and a frost plate and check valve was replaced at a residence.

Meters were read, and we are starting to get pictures of the waterlines coming into the homes.

The Annual Water Quality Report was sent to DOH for review.

On March 29<sup>th</sup> we got a call for a leak on the Osbourne bridge (Richards Ave.). We found that the 12" water main had shifted 4" and developed a leak at a coupling where it came out of the ground. We were unable to locate a shutoff for the bridge on the River St. side but was able to slow down the flow, after some investigation we were able to locate the valve and isolate the bridge. We are working with Cedarwood Engineering to do a proper repair so that won't happen again.
